Brent was involved in a variety of programs including; Landing Helicopter Dock (LHD) Training Package; Anzac Class ASMD Modification; LHD Initial in-service Support package; Commercial Oil & Gas work; and Commercial Ship repair work. In this role Brent was responsible for the Thales Australia Naval Business Group which had 900 employees. Brent has also worked for SAAB Systems and Sonartech Atlas.






