Global Supply Chain Program Expansion

The Global Supply Chain (GSC) Program is a Defence industrial participation program that contracts major global primes to integrate Australian businesses into their global supply chains. Since its inception in 2007, the GSC Program has delivered 2,450 contracts worth over \$1.9 billion to 258 Australian suppliers, achieving an average return on investment of 12-to-1.

After conducting an extensive approach to market, the Australian Government has almost doubled the number of participating major defence companies from 7 to 13.
